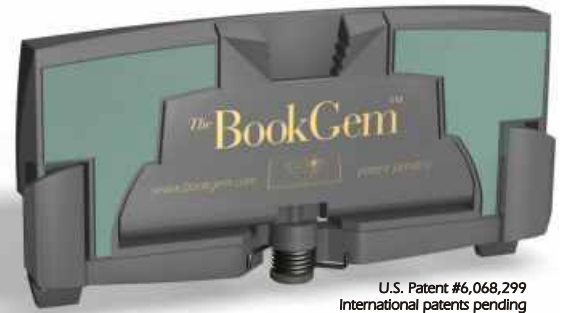

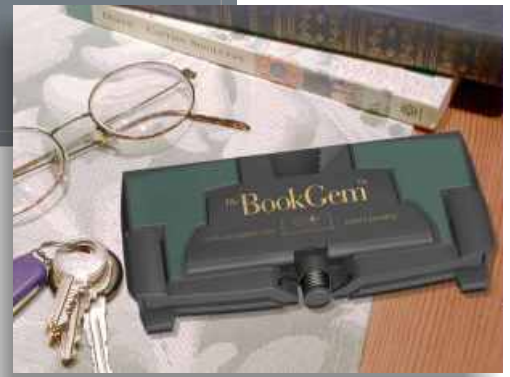

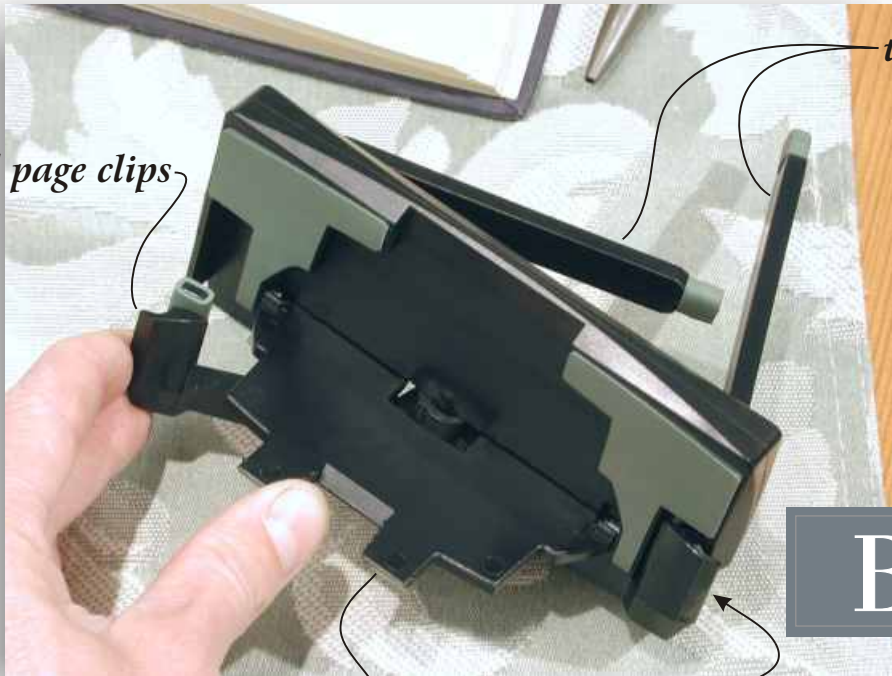

## *Turning Pages*

Hint: pull out about 20 pages in advance and slide them into the right-hand page slot.

To turn a page, simply flip the page over, raise the left-hand clip and slip the page under, and release.
